We are pleased to confirm our understanding of the services we are to provide Buckhead Trails Community Development District, Manatee County, Florida ("the District") for the fiscal years ended September 30, 2024, 2025, 2026, and 2027. We will audit the financial statements of the governmental activities and each major fund, including the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise the basic financial statements of Buckhead Trails Community Development District as of and for the fiscal years ended September 30, 2024, 2025, 2026, and 2027. In addition, we will examine the District's compliance with the requirements of Section 218.415 Florida Statutes.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America provide for certain required supplementary information (RSI), such as management's discussion and analysis (MD&A), to supplement the District's basic financial statements. Such information, although not a part of the basic financial statements, is required by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board who considers it to be an essential part of financial reporting for placing the basic financial statements in an appropriate operational, economic, or historical context. As part of our engagement, we will apply certain limited procedures to the District's RSI in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. These limited procedures will consist of inquiries of management regarding the methods of preparing the information and comparing the information for consistency with management's responses to our inquiries, the basic financial statements, and other knowledge we obtained during our audit of the basic financial statements. We will not express an opinion or provide any assurance on the information because the limited procedures do not provide us with sufficient evidence to express an opinion or provide any assurance.

The following RSI is required by generally accepted accounting principles and will be subjected to certain limited procedures, but will not be audited:

- 1) Management's Discussion and Analysis
- 2) Budgetary comparison schedule

The following other information accompanying the financial statements will not be subjected to the auditing procedures applied in our audit of the financial statements, and our auditor's report will not provide an opinion or any assurance on that information:

1) Compliance with FL Statute 218.39 (3) (c)

Audit Objectives

The objective of our audit is the expression of opinions as to whether your financial statements are fairly presented, in all material respects, in conformity with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles and to report on the fairness of the supplementary information referred to in the second paragraph when considered in relation to the financial statements as a whole. Our audit will be conducted in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards for financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States, and will include tests of the accounting records of the District and other procedures we consider necessary to enable us to express such opinions. We will issue a written report upon completion of our audit of the District's financial statements. We cannot provide assurance that an unmodified opinion will be expressed. Circumstances may arise in which it is necessary for us to modify our opinion or add emphasis-of-matter or other-matter paragraphs. If our opinion on the financial statements is other than unmodified, we will discuss the reasons with you in advance. If, for any reason, we are unable to complete the audit or are unable to form or have not formed an opinion, we may decline to express an opinion or issue a report, or may withdraw from this engagement.

We will also provide a report (that does not include an opinion) on internal control related to the financial statements and compliance with the provisions of laws, regulations, contracts, and grant agreements, noncompliance with which could have a material effect on the financial statements as required by *Government Auditing Standards*. The report on internal control and on compliance and other matters will include a paragraph that states (1) that the purpose of the report is solely to describe the scope of testing of internal control and compliance, and the results of that testing, and not to provide an opinion on the effectiveness of the District's internal control on compliance, and (2) that the report is an integral part of an audit performed in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards* in considering the District's internal control and compliance. The paragraph will also state that the report is not suitable for any other purpose. If during our audit we become aware that the District is subject to an audit requirement that is not encompassed in the terms of this engagement, we will communicate to management and those charged with governance that an audit in accordance with U.S. generally accepted auditing standards and the standards for financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards* may not satisfy the relevant legal, regulatory, or contractual requirements.

Examination Objective

The objective of our examination is the expression of an opinion as to whether the District is in compliance with Florida Statute 218.415 in accordance with Rule 10.556(10) of the Auditor General of the State of Florida. Our examination will be conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and will include tests of your records and other procedures we consider necessary to enable us to express such an opinion. We will issue a written report upon completion of our examination of the District's compliance. The report will include a statement that the report is intended solely for the information and use of management, those charged with governance, and the Florida Auditor General, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. We cannot provide assurance that an unmodified opinion will be expressed. Circumstances may arise in which it is necessary for us to modify our opinion or add emphasis-of-matter or other-matter paragraphs. If our opinion on the District's compliance is other than unmodified, we will discuss the reasons with you in advance. If, for any reason, we are unable to complete the examination or are unable to form or have not formed an opinion, we may decline to express an opinion or issue a report, or may withdraw from this engagement.

Other Services

We will assist in preparing the financial statements and related notes of the District in conformity with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles based on information provided by you. These nonaudit services do not constitute an audit under *Government Auditing Standards* and such services will not be conducted in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards*. The other services are limited to the financial statement services previously defined. We, in our sole professional judgment, reserve the right to refuse to perform any procedure or take any action that could be construed as assuming management responsibilities.

Management Responsibilities

Management is responsible for compliance with Florida Statute 218.415 and will provide us with the information required for the examination. The accuracy and completeness of such information is also management's responsibility. You agree to assume all management responsibilities relating to the financial statements and related notes and any other nonaudit services we provide. You will be required to acknowledge in the management representation letter our assistance with preparation of the financial statements and related notes and that you have reviewed and approved the financial statements and related notes prior to their issuance and have accepted responsibility for them. In addition, you will be required to make certain representations regarding compliance with Florida Statute 218.415 in the management representation letter. Further, you agree to oversee the nonaudit services by designating an individual, preferably from senior management, who possesses suitable skill, knowledge, or experience; evaluate the adequacy and results of those services; and accept responsibility for them.

Management is responsible for designing, implementing and maintaining effective internal controls, including evaluating and monitoring ongoing activities, to help ensure that appropriate goals and objectives are met; following laws and regulations; and ensuring that management and financial information is reliable and properly reported. Management is also responsible for implementing systems designed to achieve compliance with applicable laws, regulations, contracts, and grant agreements. You are also responsible for the selection and application of accounting principles, for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements and all accompanying information in conformity with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles, and for compliance with applicable laws and regulations and the provisions of contracts and grant agreements.

Management is also responsible for making all financial records and related information available to us and for the accuracy and completeness of that information. You are also responsible for providing us with (1) access to all information of which you are aware that is relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements, (2) additional information that we may request for the purpose of the audit, and (3) unrestricted access to persons within the government from whom we determine it necessary to obtain audit evidence.

Your responsibilities include adjusting the financial statements to correct material misstatements and for confirming to us in the written representation letter that the effects of any uncorrected misstatements aggregated by us during the current engagement and pertaining to the latest period presented are immaterial, both individually and in the aggregate, to the financial statements taken as a whole.

You are responsible for the design and implementation of programs and controls to prevent and detect fraud, and for informing us about all known or suspected fraud affecting the government involving (1) management, (2) employees who have significant roles in internal control, and (3) others where the fraud could have a material effect on the financial statements. Your responsibilities include informing us of your knowledge of any allegations of fraud or suspected fraud affecting the government received in communications from employees, former employees, grantors, regulators, or others. In addition, you are responsible for identifying and ensuring that the government complies with applicable laws, regulations, contracts, agreements, and grants and for taking timely and appropriate steps to remedy fraud and noncompliance with provisions of laws, regulations, contracts or grant agreements, or abuse that we report.

Management is responsible for establishing and maintaining a process for tracking the status of audit findings and recommendations. Management is also responsible for identifying and providing report copies of previous financial audits, attestation engagements, performance audits or other studies related to the objectives discussed in the Audit Objectives section of this letter. This responsibility includes relaying to us corrective actions taken to address significant findings and recommendations resulting from those audits, attestation engagements, performance audits, or other studies. You are also responsible for providing management's views on our current findings, conclusions, and recommendations, as well as your planned corrective actions, for the report, and for the timing and format for providing that information.

With regard to the electronic dissemination of audited financial statements, including financial statements published electronically on your website, you understand that electronic sites are a means to distribute information and, therefore, we are not required to read the information contained in these sites or to consider the consistency of other information in the electronic site with the original document.

Audit Procedures—General

An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements; therefore, our audit will involve judgment about the number of transactions to be examined and the areas to be tested. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements. We will plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable rather than absolute assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement, whether from (1) errors, (2) fraudulent financial reporting, (3) misappropriation of assets, or (4) violations of laws or governmental regulations that are attributable to the government or to acts by management or employees acting on behalf of the government. Because the determination of abuse is subjective, *Government Auditing Standards* do not expect auditors to provide reasonable assurance of detecting abuse.

Because of the inherent limitations of an audit, combined with the inherent limitations of internal control, and because we will not perform a detailed examination of all transactions, there is a risk that material misstatements may exist and not be detected by us, even though the audit is properly planned and performed in accordance with U.S. generally accepted auditing standards and *Government Auditing Standards*. In addition, an audit is not designed to detect immaterial misstatements or violations of laws or governmental regulations that do not have a direct and material effect on the financial statements. Our responsibility as auditors is limited to the period covered by our audit and does not extend to later periods for which we are not engaged as auditors

Our procedures will include tests of documentary evidence supporting the transactions recorded in the accounts, and may include tests of the physical existence of inventories, and direct confirmation of receivables and certain other assets and liabilities by correspondence with selected individuals, funding sources, creditors, and financial institutions. We will request written representations from your attorneys as part of the engagement, and they may bill you for responding to this inquiry. At the conclusion of our audit, we will require certain written representations from you about your responsibilities for the financial statements; compliance with laws, regulations, contracts, and grant agreements; and other responsibilities required by generally accepted auditing standards.

Audit Procedures—Internal Control

Our audit will include obtaining an understanding of the government and its environment, including internal control, sufficient to assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements and to design the nature, timing, and extent of further audit procedures. Tests of controls may be performed to test the effectiveness of certain controls that we consider relevant to preventing and detecting errors and fraud that are material to the financial statements and to preventing and detecting misstatements resulting from illegal acts and other noncompliance matters that have a direct and material effect on the financial statements. Our tests, if performed, will be less in scope than would be necessary to render an opinion on internal control and, accordingly, no opinion will be expressed in our report on internal control issued pursuant to *Government Auditing Standards*.

An audit is not designed to provide assurance on internal control or to identify significant deficiencies or material weaknesses. However, during the audit, we will communicate to management and those charged with governance internal control related matters that are required to be communicated under AICPA professional standards and *Government Auditing Standards*.

Audit Procedures—Compliance

As part of obtaining reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement, we will perform tests of the District's compliance with the provisions of applicable laws, regulations, contracts, agreements, and grants. However, the objective of our audit will not be to provide an opinion on overall compliance and we will not express such an opinion in our report on compliance issued pursuant to *Government Auditing Standards*.

Engagement Administration, Fees, and Other

We understand that your employees will prepare all confirmations we request and will locate any documents selected by us for testing.

The audit documentation for this engagement is the property of Grau & Associates and constitutes confidential information. However, subject to applicable laws and regulations, audit documentation and appropriate individuals will be made available upon request and in a timely manner to a cognizant or oversight agency or its designee, a federal agency providing direct or indirect funding, or the U.S. Government Accountability Office for purposes of a quality review of the audit, to resolve audit findings, or to carry out oversight responsibilities. We will notify you of any such request. If requested, access to such audit documentation will be provided under the supervision of Grau & Associates personnel. Furthermore, upon request, we may provide copies of selected audit documentation to the aforementioned parties. These parties may intend, or decide, to distribute the copies or information contained therein to others, including other governmental agencies. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the parties acknowledge that various documents reviewed or produced during the conduct of the audit may be public records under Florida law. The District agrees to notify Grau & Associates of any public record request it receives that involves audit documentation.

Our fee for these services will not exceed \$7,000 for the September 30, 2024 audit. The fees for the fiscal years ended September 30, 2025, September 30, 2026, and September 30, 2027 will not exceed \$7,100, \$7,200 and \$7,300, respectively, unless there is a change in activity by the District which results in additional audit work or if additional Bonds are issued.

Grau & Associates and its subcontractors warrant compliance with all federal immigration laws and regulations that relate to their employees. Grau agrees and acknowledges that the District is a public employer subject to the E-Verify requirements as set forth in Section 448.095, Florida Statutes, and that the provisions of Section 448.095, Florida Statutes apply to this Agreement. If the District has a good faith belief that the Grau has knowingly hired, recruited or referred an alien who is not authorized to work by the immigration laws or the Attorney General of the United States for employment under this Agreement,

the District shall terminate this Agreement. If the District has a good faith belief that a subcontractor performing work under this Agreement knowingly hired, recruited or referred an alien who is not duly authorized to work by the immigration laws or the Attorney General of the United States for employment under this Agreement, the District shall promptly notify Grau and order Grau to immediately terminate the contract with the subcontractor. Grau shall be liable for any additional costs incurred by the District as a result of the termination of a contract based on Grau's failure to comply with E-Verify requirements evidenced herein.

We will complete the audit within prescribed statutory deadlines, with the understanding that your employees will provide information needed to perform the audit on a timely basis.

The audit documentation for this engagement will be retained for a minimum of five years after the report release date. If we are aware that a federal awarding agency or auditee is contesting an audit finding, we will contact the party(ies) contesting the audit finding for guidance prior to destroying the audit documentation.

Our invoices for these fees will be rendered each month as work progresses and are payable on presentation. Invoices will be submitted in sufficient detail to demonstrate compliance with the terms of this agreement. In accordance with our firm policies, work may be suspended if your account becomes 60 days or more overdue and may not be resumed until your account is paid in full. If we elect to terminate our services for nonpayment, our engagement will be deemed to have been completed upon written notification of termination, even if we have not completed our report. You will be obligated to compensate us for all time expended and to reimburse us for all out-of-pocket costs through the date of termination. The above fee is based on anticipated cooperation from your personnel and the assumption that unexpected circumstances will not be encountered during the audit. If significant additional time is necessary, we will discuss it with you and arrive at a new fee estimate.

This agreement may be renewed each year thereafter subject to the mutual agreement by both parties to all terms and fees. The fee for each annual renewal will be agreed upon separately.

The District has the option to terminate this agreement with or without cause by providing thirty (30) days written notice of termination to Grau & Associates. Upon any termination of this agreement, Grau & Associates shall be entitled to payment of all work and/or services rendered up until the effective termination of this agreement, subject to whatever claims or off-sets the District may have against Grau & Associates.

We will provide you with a copy of our most recent external peer review report and any letter of comment, and any subsequent peer review reports and letters of comment received during the period of the contract. Our 2022 peer review report accompanies this letter.

We appreciate the opportunity to be of service to Buckhead Trails Community Development District and believe this letter accurately summarizes the significant terms of our engagement. Aquatic Management Agreement

This Aquatic Management Agreement (this "Agreement") is entered into as of November 1, 2024, between the **Buckhead Trails Community Development District** (the "**District**"), and **Bayhead Ecological Solutions**, **LLC**, a Florida limited liability company (the "**Contractor**").

Background Information:

The District is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the wetlands within the boundaries of the District. The Contractor provides wetland maintenance services and the District desires to retain the Contractor to provide quarterly maintenance of the wetland buffers as described in this Agreement.

Operative Provisions:

- **1.** <u>Incorporation of Background Information</u>. The background information stated above is true and correct and by this reference is incorporated by reference as a material part of this Agreement.
- 2. <u>Scope of Services</u>. The Contractor shall perform the specific maintenance services described in their scope of work, relevant parts of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit A** for the District's ponds depicted in the map included in their scope of work.
- 3. Manner of Performance and Care of the Property.
 - a. The work shall be done, furnished, and performed in a workmanlike manner to the satisfaction of the District and shall be in accordance with the best management practices in the industry.
 - b. Contractor agrees to keep property clean and orderly during the course of the work and to remove all materials, debris, equipment, and machinery at the completion of each work day.
 - c. Contractor shall use all due care to protect the property of the District, its residents and landowners from damage. Contractor agrees to repair or replace, to the District's satisfaction, any damage resulting from Contractor's activities and work within 24 hours. In the event Contractor does not repair or replace the damage to District's satisfaction, Contractor shall be responsible for reimbursing District for such damages or the District may elect to deduct the costs of the repair from the payment to Contractor for the work under this Agreement.
- **4.** <u>Compensation</u>. The District agrees to compensate the Contractor for the work described above in the amount of \$2,890.00 per event to be paid after each quarterly service. The District shall pay the Contractor within 45 days of receipt of the invoice. The total fee of services rendered over the term of this Agreement is \$11,560.00.
- **5.** <u>Additional Services</u>. When authorized in advance in writing by the District, the Contractor may provide additional services beyond those listed above.
- **6.** <u>Term of this Agreement</u>. The initial term of this Agreement shall be for one year from the date of this Agreement.
- **Termination.** Either party may terminate this Agreement without cause with 30 days written notice to the other party. Upon termination of this Agreement, the Contractor shall be entitled to payment for all work and/or services rendered up until the effective termination of this Agreement, subject to whatever claims or off-sets the District may have against the Contractor.

- **8.** Relationship Between the Parties. It is understood that the Contractor is an independent contractor and shall perform the services contemplated under this Agreement. As an independent contractor, nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to create a partnership, joint venture, or employer-employee relationship between the Contractor and the District. The Contractor shall not have the right to make any contract or commitments for, or on behalf of, the District without the prior written approval of the District. The Contractor assumes full responsibility for the payment and reporting of all local, state, and federal taxes and other contributions imposed or required of the Contractor during the performance of services to the District.
- 9. Compliance with Governmental Regulation. The Contractor shall keep, observe, and perform all requirements of applicable local, State, and Federal laws, rules, regulations, or ordinances, including conservation easements applicable to the District. If the Contractor fails to notify the District in writing within 5 days of the receipt of any notice, order, required to comply notice, or a report of a violation or an alleged violation, made by any local, State, or Federal governmental body or agency or subdivision thereof with respect to the services being rendered under this Agreement or any action of the Contractor or any of its agents, servants, employees, or material men, or with respect to terms, wages, hours, conditions of employment, safety appliances, or any other requirements applicable to provision of services, or fails to comply with any requirement of such agency within 5 days after receipt of any such notice, order, request to comply notice, or report of a violation or an alleged violation, the District may terminate this Agreement, such termination to be effective immediately upon the giving of notice of termination.
- **10.** <u>Insurance.</u> The Contractor or any subcontractor performing the work described in this Agreement shall maintain throughout the term of this Agreement the following insurance:
 - a. Worker's Compensation Insurance in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.
 - b. Commercial General Liability Insurance covering the Contractor's legal liability for bodily injuries, with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit bodily injury and property damage liability and covering at least the following hazards: Independent Contractors Coverage for bodily injury and property damage in connection with subcontractors' operation.
 - c. Employer's Liability Coverage with limits of at least \$1,000,000 per accident or disease.
 - d. Automobile Liability Insurance for bodily injuries in limits of not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit bodily injury and for property damage, providing coverage for any accident arising out of or resulting from the operation, maintenance, or use by the Contractor of any owned, non-owned, or hired automobiles, trailers, or other equipment required to be licensed.

The District, its staff, consultants and supervisors shall be named as an additional insured. The Contractor shall furnish the District with the Certificate of Insurance evidencing compliance with this requirement. No certificate shall be acceptable to the District unless it provides that any change or termination within the policy periods of the insurance coverage, as certified, shall not be effective within 30 days of prior written notice to the District. Insurance coverage shall be from a reputable insurance carrier, licensed to conduct business in the State of Florida.

11. <u>Indemnification</u>. Contractor agrees to indemnify and hold the District and its officers, agents and employees harmless from any and all liability, claims, actions, suits, demands and obligations by any person, corporation or other entity for injuries, death, property damage or of any nature, arising out of, or in connection with, the work to be performed by Contractor. Obligations shall include the payment of all settlements, judgments, damages, penalties, forfeitures, back pay, court costs,

arbitration and/or mediation costs, litigation expenses, attorney's fees and paralegal fees (whether in court, out of court, on appeal or in bankruptcy proceedings), as ordered.

- 12. <u>Limitations on Governmental Liability</u>. 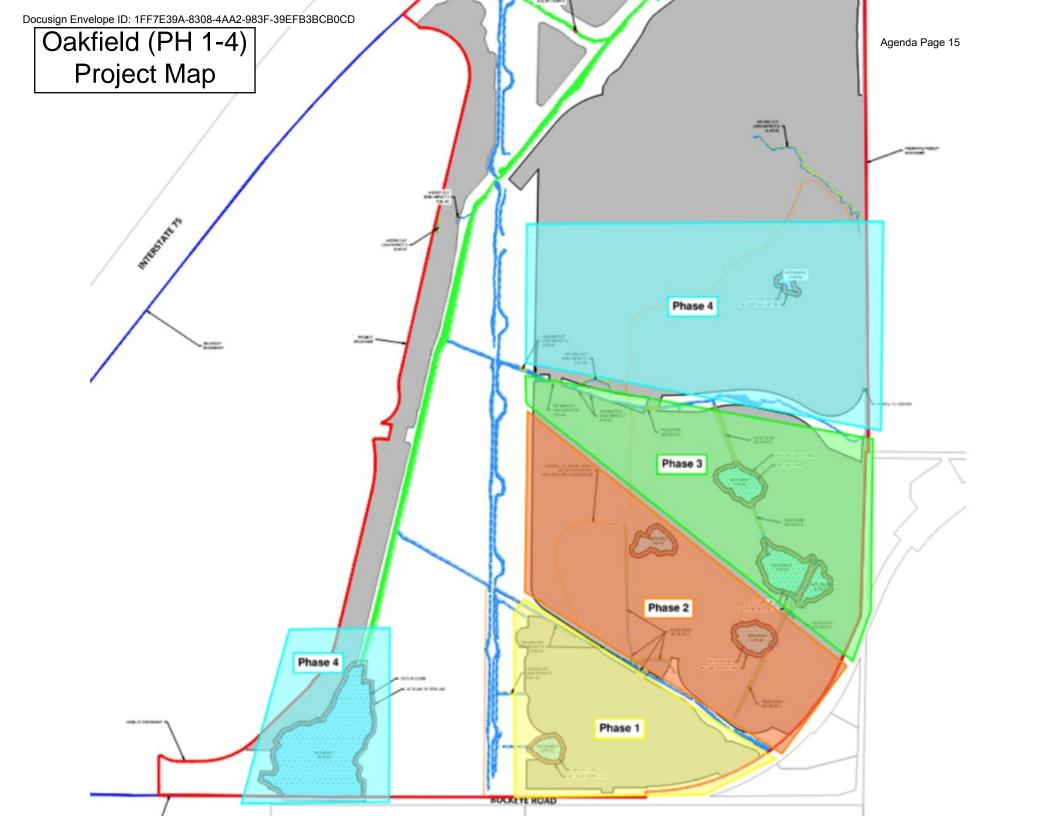

SCOPE OF WORK

1.0 QUARTERLY HERBACEOUS TREATMENT

Bayhead will also execute maintenance spray events on all Florida Invasive Species Council (FISC) listed Category I, II or III nuisance exotic or invasive flora/vegetation within the wetland buffer enhancements listed below. These events are priced such that they begin within 90 days after the initial removal event and occur quarterly. These events are also limited to wetland enhancement buffers of WF, WH, WI, WJ, WK, WL, WM, WN as defined on the enclosed Oakfield (PH 1-4) project map.



Water Meter Reading Services Agreement

This Water Meter Reading Services Agreement (this "Agreement") is entered into as of January 9, 2025 between the **Buckhead Trails Community Development District**, a local unit of special-purpose government established pursuant to Chapter 190, Florida Statutes (the "**District**"), and **Pacscon Geoenvironmental, Inc.**, a Florida profit corporation (the "**Contractor**").

Background Information:

The District desires for the Contractor to provide monthly water meter readings in accordance with its Water Use Permit ("WUP") issued by the Southwest Florida Water Management District ("SWFWMD"). The District also desires to have the Contractor assess the condition of the water wells. The Contractor represents that it is duly licensed in the state of Florida and qualified to perform the job duties and has any and all approvals and licenses as required by law to provide these services. The Contractor is familiar with the District's property. In consideration of the Contractor's agreement to perform the services described below and the District's agreement to compensate the Contractor the parties desire to enter into this Agreement.

Operative Provisions:

- **1.** <u>Incorporation of Background Information</u>. The background information stated above is true and correct and by this reference is incorporated as a material part of this Agreement.
- 2. Scope of Services. The Contractor shall perform all work, including all labor, material, equipment, supplies, tools, supervision, services, transportation, and all other necessary incidental items required for the complete performance of the work described in Contractor's proposal, relevant portions of which are attached hereto as Exhibit A to ensure that the District's WUP conditions imposed by SWFWMD are in compliance. Contractor shall coordinate with the District Manager for questions or clarifications on the scope of the work or the work schedule.

3. Performance of Work.

- a. Contractor shall take precautions at all times to protect any persons and property affected by Contractor's work.
- b. All work shall be performed in a neat and professional manner reasonably acceptable to the District and shall be in accordance with industry standards and best management practices.
- c. The Contractor agrees that the District shall not be liable for the payment of any work or services unless the District, through an authorized representative of the District, authorizes the Contractor, in writing, to perform such work.
- d. The Contractor shall supply all materials needed to perform the services described in Exhibit A.
- e. **Standard of Care.** Services performed by Consultant under this Agreement will be conducted in a manner consistent to the level of competency presently maintained by other practicing professional scientists under similar conditions in the location where the services are performed, for professional and technical soundness, accuracy, and adequacy of all work and materials furnished under the Agreement. Consultant makes no other warranty express or implied, including without limitation, any warranty of fitness for a particular purpose.
- **4.** Responsibilities of the District. The District will provide access to the water meters in need of monthly readings and accuracy testing.

5. Compensation.

- a. Contractor shall perform the work described above for the aggregate amount not to exceed \$12,000.00 in payments described below:
 - i. The District will pay to Contractor on a monthly basis the amount of \$1,000.00 for monthly meter readings and well condition assessment as described in **Exhibit A**.
- b. The Contractor shall submit an invoice for the work performed on a monthly basis and the District shall pay the Contractor within 45 days of receipt of the invoice.
- **6.** <u>Term.</u> The initial term of this Agreement shall be for 1 year from the date of this Agreement. At the end of the initial term, this Agreement shall automatically renew for the same term and contract provisions as the initial term, until terminated by either party pursuant to the termination provision below.
- **Termination.** Either party may terminate this Agreement without cause with 30 days written notice to the other party. Upon termination of this Agreement, the Contractor shall be entitled to payment for all work and/or services rendered up until the effective termination of this Agreement, subject to whatever claims or off-sets the District may have against the Contractor.

Insurance coverage shall be from a reputable insurance carrier, licensed to conduct business in the State of Florida.

Obligations shall include the proportion payment of reasonable settlements, judgments, damages, penalties, forfeitures, back pay, court costs, arbitration and/or mediation costs, litigation expenses, attorney's fees and paralegal fees (whether in court, out of court, on appeal or in bankruptcy proceedings), as ordered.

- 12. <u>Limitations on Governmental Liability</u>. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed as a waiver of immunity or limits of liability of the District beyond any statutory limited waiver of immunity or limits of liability which may have been adopted by the Florida Legislature in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes or other statute, and nothing in this Agreement shall inure to the benefit of any third party for the purpose of allowing any claim which would otherwise be barred under the Doctrine of Sovereign Immunity or by operation of law.
- 13. Relationship Between the Parties. It is understood that the Contractor is an independent contractor and shall perform the services contemplated under this Agreement. Pursuant to your request, PACSCON GeoEnvironmental, Inc. (PACSCON) is pleased to provide this proposal to Inframark Infrastructure Management Services (the Client) for the completion of professional environmental services at the Subject Property as discussed further herein.

The following sections discuss our understanding of the project and provide our proposed scope of services, budget, and schedule.

PROJECT BACKGROUND & UNDERSTANDING

The Subject Property is generally situated north of Buckeye Road and east of Interstate 75 (I-75, or Highway 93A) within an unincorporated area of Manatee County, Florida. Water Use Permit (WUP) No. 20 005309.015 was approved by the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) for the Subject Property on May 14, 2024 for the use of up to nine total irrigation supply wells. The wells approved for use in this permit include the following along with their installation status:

- No. 12 Installed
- No. 19 Installed
- No. 20 Not Installed
- No. 21 Installed

- No. 22 Not Installed
- No. 23 Installed
- No. 24 Not Installed
- No. 25 Not Installed
- No. 26 Not Installed

The approximate locations of these wells are shown on the adjacent map; existing or installed wells (Nos. 12, 19, 21, and 23) are noted with blue circles while wells not yet installed (Nos. 20, 22, 24, 25, and 26) are noted with purple circles. Of the installed wells, Nos. 19, 21, and 23



have been installed within the current Oakfield Lakes residential development currently under construction. Well No. 12 is located approximately ½ mile west within an unmaintained orange grove area.

PACSCON completed a preliminary reconnaissance of the Subject Property on December 10, 2024 to evaluate the current wells, their apparent condition, and meters. Well Nos. 19, 21, and 23 were easily accessible and appeared to be in good condition with flow meters already attached, while Well No. 12 was within a grove area behind a locked gate and was not accessible at the time of the site visit.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Under this proposal, PACSCON will complete *monthly* meter readings and reporting for the three irrigation supply wells presently located within the active Oakfield Groves development (Well Nos. 19, 21, and 23) and adjoining grove land (Well No. 12). PACSCON staff will mobilize to the site, record current well readings, and note any observations regarding the wells' condition that may need repair or other attention. A summary will be provided to the client with the meter readings and noted observations. Further, PACSCON will submit the required data to the SWFWMD on behalf of the client using the District Permit Information Center www.swfwmd.state.fl.us/permits/epermitting/. Pursuant to the conditions of the WUP, data will be collected within the last week of the month and submitted to the SWFWMD on or before the tenth day of the month following data collection.

Additional access considerations and coordination with the Client and property owner (JSH Buckeye Road Development LLC) will be required to provide access and necessary observations to comply with the permit requirements and conditions for Well No. 12.



SCHEDULE

Following approval to proceed, PACSCON will complete the proposed meter readings on a monthly basis, during the last week of the month, in accordance with the WUP conditions. Data will be provided to the Client in a summary email and will be submitted to the SWFWMD on or before the tenth day of the month following data collection.

This proposal assumes service for one year, or for twelve monthly data recording and reporting events. PACSCON will keep the Client apprised of the anticipated data collection schedule.

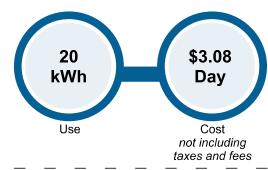
